Help affect change in the Chambersburg area. Join the *Chambersburg Area Conference of Lutheran Churches* and help the homeless move forward and into a home.

How does it work?

Once a homeless person/family is in the place to move into an apartment, the ministry is notified and helps by providing needed furniture and household items.

Three Ways to Help:

1. Donate money.
2. Donate time.
3. Donate household items.

1. **Donate money.**

Checks made out to *St. Luke Lutheran*, with "Homeless Connection" in the Memo" -money will go to purchase needed items, specifically mattresses.

2. **Donate time.**

Help by driving your truck or help physically moving items. Give your name and phone number to Shelly Davies and she will make sure it gets added to the list. When help is needed you will be called.

3. **Donate household items.**

*Small items can be brought to the church and left in **Classroom #3**. They will be delivered to the storage shed once a week. Furniture donations can be delivered to the storage shed directly or pick up can be arranged-please contact Shelly Davies 717-372-9579.*

This is an ongoing ministry and furniture and household items can be accepted anytime of the year!

Accepting:

- Kitchen Furnishings
 - Dishes, Bowls, Plates, Silverware, glasses (please box by family size-family of 4, family of 6)
 - Storage Containers
 - Pots/Pans
 - Small Appliances (Toasters, can openers)
- Cleaning Supplies
 - Brooms, Dustpans
 - Rags, Garbage Bags, Dusters
 - Waste baskets
- Bedroom Furnishings
 - Sheets, blankets, pillows (please label sheets with size)
 - Mattresses/Box Springs (Queen size or smaller)
 - Nightstands & Lamps
- Small Chest or Dresser for clothes
- Hangers & Hampers
- Living Room Furnishings
 - Small Chairs (Rockers/Recliners) or Lounge Chairs
 - Floor Lamps
 - Small Flat Screen TV's
 - Shelving Units
 - Table Lamps
 - Side Tables
- Dining Room Furnishings
 - Table/Chairs

Not Accepting:

- Old Analog TV's
- King Size Mattresses/Box Springs
- Rusted Items or items with major damage
- Oversized items (due to the limited space available for clients)
