OUTREACH

ST. SERAPHIM CENTER

We have been serving alongside St. Mary's Orthodox for one year now at the St. Seraphim Center (soup kitchen). Thank you so much for stepping up, especially as our start was in conjunction with the start of COVID. Your donations of soup, cookies, and other necessary items has been wonderful. Our next service date will be May 1. We are happy to give St. Mary's a break that day as it is their orthodox Easter celebration!

AUDIO/VISUAL EQUIPMENT INSTALL

As part of our endeavor to be safer and more accessible during these times, the COVID Taskforce has been working with a local audio/visual company to make streaming to YouTube easier, as well as to make in-person worship hands-free. In December, they came and installed some equipment (we're already using it!), and we anticipate the project to be finished in the coming month with the addition of a few new microphones. If you've watched our live stream on YouTube, you'll be grateful for the new mics!

POWERPACKS

St. Luke has continued to provide PowerPacks for food-insecure students at three local schools during the past year. Although numbers are lower than last year (that's a good thing!) we've still been serving between 40-45 children per week, providing four meals, snacks and drinks for the weekend). Our last month for this school year is May.

The first Church Council meeting for 2021 was held on January 25 via Zoom. Each council member was assigned to one of the standing committees to attend their meetings and provide a report back to council on committee business.
