

A LETTER FROM PASTOR FRYE

October 2022



Dear Family and Friends of St. Luke,

Many of you are aware that the local Stephen Ministry community outreach was discontinued about a year ago due to cutbacks in program funding. The good news is that because of the generosity of a recent memorial gift to our congregation, we will be able to reinstitute this valuable ministry.

Stephen Ministry offers a proven and effective way to organize, equip, and supervise a team of congregation members—called Stephen Ministers—to provide high-quality, one-to-one, Christ-centered care to people in the congregation and the community experiencing life difficulties. Both Cheryl Vorhauer and Carol Angstadt have experience with this ministry and a desire to explore ways it may be implemented in our context. At this point our congregation is registered with Stephen Ministry and Cheryl, Carol, and I have enrolled in training that begins on October 18.

People often ask, "What exactly is a Stephen Minister?" One way to put it is that Stephen Ministers are the After People.

Stephen Ministers are there: . . . after the phone call you hoped you'd never get. . . . after the funeral, when everyone has left and the emotions you've held at bay come crashing in on you. . . . after the relationship falls apart and the bottom falls out of your life. . . . after the doctor says, "I'm sorry, but there's nothing more we can do." . . . after the nursing home director shakes your hand and says, "Welcome to your new home." . . . after the last child honks the horn, waves, and drives away—and the house suddenly seems empty. . . . after the gavel comes down, the handcuffs go on, and your loved one is led away. . . . after the baby arrives, demanding more of you than you ever dreamed possible. . . . after you find a pink slip with your final paycheck. . . . after your family and friends have heard your story one too many times, but you still need to talk it out.

Stephen Ministers are the After People. They are ready to come alongside you—or your friends, neighbors, coworkers, or relatives—and provide comfort and support for as long after as needed.

Please keep this initiative in your prayers. It won't materialize overnight. We will share more as we continue in the process.

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS AUGUST 2022

- The website is being updated and should be up and running in early October. Object of the update is to make the website more user friendly.
