I will deliver you, and you shall honor me.

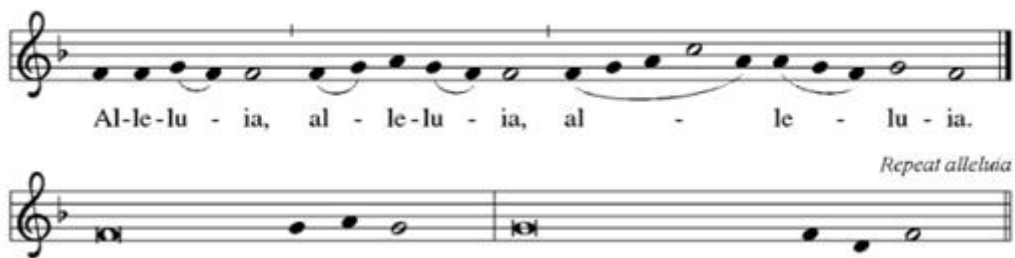
