The presiding minister announces God's forgiveness with these or similar words.

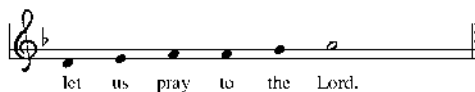
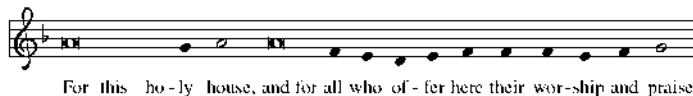
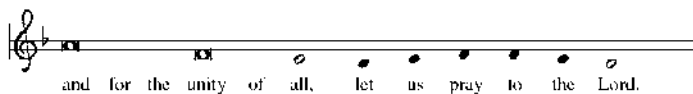
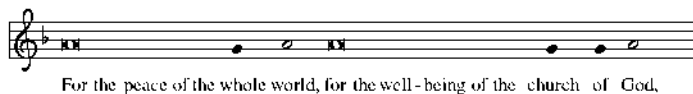
