Dry Food Donations

canned soup	chicken stock or bouillon cubes

dry beans	coffee (regular)

Physical Plant Needs

Door on food pantry with lock
Movable counter with stainless steel top & cupboards below
(about 4.5 feet long and 39 inches tall)
Light above sink
Window blinds for front windows
