# A LETTER FROM PASTOR FRYE

August / September 2023

Dear Family and Friends of St. Luke,

+ Grace and Peace to you

Since this is a newsletter, I thought it would be appropriate to share the news with you that there are two new ministries beginning in September. The first is a bible study, the second is a ministry with the recovery community.

I will be leading a bible study on Tuesday, September 19th at 11:00 AM in the church library. Thereafter we will gather on the 1st and 3rd Tuesdays of each month at 11:00 AM for this lectionary-based study, discussion, and fellowship. No experience is necessary! Just bring your bible and a willing heart. (If you do not have a bible, one will be provided.)

On Wednesday evening, September 20 at 5:30 a potluck dinner will be held in the fellowship hall. This time of fellowship is for people in search of growth, healing, and recovery. Through bible study, reflection, discussion, and prayer, those in the recovery community (new or experienced) will gather on the third Wednesday of each month for an intentional time of recovery of hope in Christ.

If you are interested in either of these two ministries, please let me know. More information will be forthcoming in the weeks ahead.

Something that has been ongoing is our concerted effort to work with our neighboring congregation, St. Paul Lutheran Church in Fayetteville. On Monday, July 31 a joint task force of representatives from St. Luke and St. Paul is gathering for the first of a series of meetings to discuss possibilities for continued and more intentional cooperation.

Along those lines, there is also a gathering being held on Saturday, September 30 for representatives from all congregations of the Chambersburg Conference of Lutheran Churches to consider the need and potential for consolidation and collaboration among the 19 congregations of the Conference. The work that we have begun with St. Paul and the Conococheague Mission Cooperative is being highlighted at this gathering. Your prayers are requested as these discussions and prayerful discernment continue.

Meanwhile, blessings to you in these remaining weeks of summer. I am looking forward to a time of rest and renewal in the weeks ahead. I ask for your ongoing prayers for our shared life together in Christ.
