PROCESSION OF THE CROSS

As the crucifix is brought into the church, the following is said three times:

Behold, the life-giving cross on which was hung the salvation of the whole world.

Oh, come, let us worship him.

As the crucifix is placed at the altar, the people are seated.

A period of silence follows. During this time, worshipers may come forward to show reverence. Reverencing the cross may include actions such as pausing before the cross, bowing, kneeling before it for prayer, or touching it.

The presiding minister continues:

...We adore you, O Christ, and we bless you.

By your holy cross you have redeemed the world.
