ATHANASIAN CREED

One of the three ecumenical statements of faith, along with the Apostles' Creed and the Nicene Creed. Though named for Athanasius, Bishop of Alexandria (d. 373), this creed was probably written by others at a much later period. It is also known by the title, Quicunque Vult ("whosoever will"), because of the opening words of this creed. This creed is characterized by its stress on the doctrines of the Trinity and the Incarnation.




